
The Future of Ageing in Asia

The inaugural **DBS Foundation Impact Beyond Summit** was held on 11 November 2024 at a decommissioned power station formerly known as "Pasir Panjang Power Station B". This historic landmark was reimagined for the event, embodying our mission to redefine ageing and the belief that even familiar, established structures can be re-energised with new purpose.

Over 300 business leaders, longevity experts, and social sector representatives joined and heard from luminaries like President Tharman Shanmugaratnam, Ex-DBS CEO Piyush Gupta, Dan Buettner of Blue Zones fame, Professor John Eu-Li Wong of National University of Singapore & National University Health System, amongst other leading voices.

Lifespans on average may have increased today, but the real challenge – and goal – lies in improving "living spans" too, i.e. narrowing the gap between life spans and health spans, ensuring more years of good health and vitality. By driving community initiatives, forging public-private partnerships, and empowering social enterprises, DBS Foundation aims to help shape a future where everyone – regardless of age or circumstance – can age well.















Reimagining Ageing: From A Spark Within to Impact Beyond

- Highlight issues Asia's ageing societies face and emphasise the need for collaboration in tackling them so that everyone can age with purpose, dignity and joy.

 The summit highlighted the importance of changing mindsets viewing ageing not from a lens of deficit, but an opportunity–, where older adults can actively contribute to communities and economies.



Proven Platform for Advocacy and Ecosystem Impact


